First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4 day day of February
A. D. 1923, at Fillmore County of Millard
and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable John L. Knox presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to ten years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable John J. Higgins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Thomas Joseph Mc Nally

I was convicted under the name of Thomas J. Mc Nally

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny
