First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of December
A. D. 1922, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James N. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Carl Skeie
I was convicted under the name of L. A. Jarvis

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Stephen R. Taintor.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except 2nd Deg. Burglary in
State of Montana.
