County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term One to twenty years.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers District Attorney. prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Baldwin.

I was convicted under the name of George Baldwin.
