Application of James Fotopulos

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of June A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Hutchinson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Brown.

I was convicted under the name of James Fotopulos

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Second Degree Burglary
