under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of June
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial Dist. Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. J. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Brown
I was convicted under the name of James Fotepulos

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except 1st degree
Burglary 1915 for which offense I served a
term of 1 1/2 years in the Utah State Prison
