Application of C. E. Price

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison;  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carotivage

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the ninth day of October  
A. D. 1922, at Price, Utah. County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in fifth district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Woods presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to not to exceed five years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth--Honorable A plea of guilty prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Charles Edward Price  
I was convicted under the name of Charles E. Price

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except Federal charges
