STATEMENT TO THE BOARD OF PARDONS.

Hon. State Board of Pardons,
Salt Lake City, Utah.

Gentlemen:

The defendant in this case, C. E. Price, was charged by the information of the District Attorney of the Seventh Judicial District, with the crime of Carnally and unlawfully knowing a female over the age of thirteen years and under the age of eighteen years, and was, on the 10th day of October, A. D. 1922, convicted of the said crime upon his own plea of guilty, and waiving time for the pronouncing of judgment and requesting that the judgment of the Court be pronounced forthwith, the defendant was, on the said 10th day of October, A. D. 1922, sentenced to imprisonment in the State Prison of the State of Utah, for an indeterminate period not exceeding five years.

As to this defendant the Court is without much information and as to the circumstances of this offense the court is also without information which could be of value to your honorable board. I may say, however, that this defendant has served a sentence in the state prison of the State of Texas.

In view of the Court's limited knowledge of this defendant and of the circumstances surrounding the commission of this offense, it would be the recommendation of this Court that the penalty in this case be that the defendant be incarcerated in the State Prison of the State of Utah for a period of one year, provided, of course, that his conduct while in the State Prison shall be proper and commendable.
