Application of James F. Workman

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the eleventh day of December
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City Utah County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in The third Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An Indeterminate Term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel G. Clauson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Freemont Workman
I was convicted under the name of J. F. Workman

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Leo W. Robinson (Terminated) Lester Gerber (Paroled)

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
