I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of December  
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in The Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chas. Mathison presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
at Sugar House Utah

Fourth-Honorable Samuel E. Clancy prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Fremont Workman  
I was convicted under the name of J. F. Workman

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Lester Herbert (Borah)  
Leo W. Robinson Terminated

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Robbery
