State v. Wiley Long.

Honorable State Board of Pardons,  
Salt Lake City.

Gentlemen:

On the 14th of November, 1922, the District Attorney of this Judicial District filed an information in the District Court of Weber County charging one Wiley Long with the crime of grand larceny, to-wit: with stealing and carrying away certain personal property belonging to H. Frowley, namely, a large package of ladies' suits having a value in excess of \$50. On November 15th, 1922, the defendant appeared personally in court and, on being arraigned, entered his plea of guilty to the charge, waived the statutory time for the passing of sentence and was adjudged to be imprisoned in the state prison for a period of not less than one year nor more than ten years.

I know nothing of the history of this man and have no means of acquiring such a history. I am, therefore, in no position to make any recommendation in the case.
