Application of C. A. Inlow

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Murder

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of May A. D. 1913, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Life and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is C. A. Inlow I was convicted under the name of C. A. Inlow
