I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 2d Deg, Committed to March 1st, 1926

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of May
A. D. 1913, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Life, (subsequently commuted to March 1st, 1926.)
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. O. Leatherwood prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is C. A. Inlow
I was convicted under the name of C. A. Inlow

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except This one.
