Application of Charles Haney

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of January A. D. 1925, at Ogden Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James N. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 1 to 20 yrs

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles Haney
I was convicted under the name of Charles Haney

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: James Ryan Kenneth Gardner

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except

Petty Larceny in Penna.

If I am Released it is my intention to go to Wyoming to work in the oil fields and have several friends there
