Application of

Concepcion Delgado

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Penitentiary of Salt Lake City under conviction and a sentence on a charge of man slaughter.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Ninth day of November A. D. 1922., at Price, County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable F. E. Woods presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary of Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable V. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Concepcion Delgado. I was convicted under the name of Concepcion Delgado.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Jose Carpio y Daniel Chavez.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except never.
