Application of Concepcion Delgado

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of November
A. D. 1922, at Price County of Carson
and State of Utah, in 7th Dist Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable F. E. Woods presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to ten
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.
