Application of Leo L. Buckbee

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the ninth day of July
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable William S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate period of from
six months to three years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Leo Lee Buckbee
I was convicted under the name of Leo Lee Buckbee

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except I have been
convicted before.
