under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of October
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. M. McCreary presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John B. Thorpe
I was convicted under the name of John B. Thorpe

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Forgery
