Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of Nov
A. D. 1921, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chas. S. Barber presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 5 years & Life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah St. Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph H. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Stanfield
I was convicted under the name of James Stanfield

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: James Brax

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Murder
