and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Five Years to life.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Stanfield.  
I was convicted under the name of James Stanfield.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: James Bray.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except  
This one.
