Application of Tom Carey

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Highway Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of May  
A. D. 1926, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence  
of Five years to life  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
at Salt Lake City Utah

Fourth-- Honorable J. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank L. Burns  
I was convicted under the name of Tom Carey.
