THE COURT: You had gone from 2665 Wall, and had taken the shirt with you, then, and gone to this other hotel?

DEFENDANT OWYHEE: No, sir, I didn't take it all the way, because I and Mr. Carel, we walked up the street. He said he was hungry, and I told him I was too and I had a shirt here, I said, and I said, "Go and pawn it, and we will go up here,--" and he did, and we went and ate.

THE COURT: You pawned the shirt?

DEFENDANT OWYHEE: Yes, sir.

THE COURT: And used the money and purchased food, is that it?

DEFENDANT OWYHEE: Yes, sir.

THE COURT: The judgment of the court is that Theos. Owyhee, having plead guilty to the crime of Burglary in the 3rd Degree, be imprisoned in the State Prison for a term of not less than six months and for not more than three years, as provided by the statute,
