I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal knowledge of a female over
the age of 13 years and under the age of 18 years.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd. day of December
A. D. 1923, at Logan County of Cache
and State of Utah, in the First Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate term not exceeding five
years.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison on July 9th 1924.

Fourth-- Honorable LeRoy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank L. Rutledge
I was convicted under the name of Frank L. Rutledge

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None. Clara Liechty was complaining witness.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which
I am now serving sentence.
