and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence
of One to Twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Robert B. Warren
I was convicted under the name of Robert B. Warren
