In Re R. G. WARREN application  
for termination of sentence.

Pursuant to request contained in your letter of the 2nd Inst for information regarding this prisoner; I have to say that this prisoner was sentenced January 18th, 1924 upon his plea of guilty of the crime of forgery. The sum obtained by the forgery was \$40.00 upon a check for that amount drawn by him on the Utah National Bank to which check he signed the name of G. R. Willett and endorsed R. C. Warren.

I have no information as to the man's former life or as to his conduct prior to his commission of this offense; but it seems to me in view of the fact that the crime of forgery seems to be somewhat rampant in this district at least, that there would be no justification in terminating this man's sentence prior to the expiration of the minimum term.
