Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Twenty first day of February
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge L. B. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Mc Dowell
I was convicted under the name of E. C. Clark

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

E. A. Harrison (Paroled)
