Dear Sir:- If it pleases your honorable integrity, surely you will give this letter your kind attention, and in learning the nature of my intrusion upon your ability and office I am sure that your honor will be perfectly at ease after indulging in the matter thoroughly.

On or about the 5th day of August, 1923, I plead guilty to a charge of Burglary, 3rd degree, and was sentenced too from 6 months to 3 years. Twice I have been an applicant for termination, but in not having the proper representation my efforts made no impression upon the Honorable Board of Pardons. Now I appeal to your honor for your co-operation and efficient aid and beg leave to impose upon your kindness for a rehearing on the September meeting of the Honorable Board of Pardons, as such action I believe would bring about my freedom in September.
