Application of Sam L. Fitchie

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of August A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McCreary presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Dist. Atty. Hutchinson prosecuted the case.
