I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon (or future date) and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the eleventh day of August A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Dist. Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McCre presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from five years to life (5 to life) and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Miss Atty Hutchins prosecuted the case.
