First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in This Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Eleventh day of August A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge W. E. Greer presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of Five yrs. to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
