The defendant Harry Schroader, pleaded guilty to the crime of burglary in the third degree, and on said date was sentenced to serve a term in the state prison as provided by law. I have been unable to ascertain anything about the past record of Mr. Schroader, and therefore any recommendation that I might make would be of but little assistance to the Board of Pardons. He, however, seems to be a man of mature judgment, and in my opinion a period of one year would be a proper punishment for the crime that he committed.
