Application of Harry Schroeder

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a probation or termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of third degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of June  
A. D. 1925, at Provo County of Provo  
and State of Utah, in fourth District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Elias Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term  
of from six months to three years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Harry Schroeder  
I was convicted under the name of Harry Schroeder

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Joseph Lebow

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except third degree  
burglary in May 27 1924
