First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of June A. D. 1923, at Provo, County of Provo, and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Elias Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 6 months to 3 years.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Harry Schroeder. I was convicted under the name of Harry Schroeder.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Joseph Ledoux.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except

3rd Degree Burglary.
