Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of June  
A. D. 1925, at Provo County of Provo  
and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. B. Hanson presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to Utah State Prison  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable J. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Harry Schroeder  
I was convicted under the name of Harry Schroeder

Sixth -- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Joseph Tedoux

Seventh -- I have never been convicted of any offense except Third Degree Burglary.
