I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination to leave the State
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21 day of November
A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable White presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of
5 years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Walter Ralph
I was convicted under the name of William Walter Ralph

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Earl Leadbetter

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
