Application of Roy Albert Smiley

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Rehearing
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 28, day of July
A. D. 1923, at Price County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to From One to Twenty Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Dist. Att. Walton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Clarence Merton Kramer
I was convicted under the name of Roy Albert Smiley

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except About nine
years ago I was sentenced to
sixty days in the county jail at
San Francisco Calif.
