Second -- I was convicted and sentenced on the 30th day of July A. D. 1923, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christerson presiding.

Third -- I was sentenced to From one to Twenty Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth -- Honorable Walton prosecuted the case.

Fifth -- My true name in full is Roy Albert Smiley I was convicted under the name of Roy Albert Smiley
