Application of Don Boyd.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the second day of November A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve an Indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Don Boyd I was convicted under the name of Don Boyd.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except.
