and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of Don Boyd

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Hank Higgins, Jack Culver and Jack Nash.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny.
