I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of January
A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Richard Neubauer
I was convicted under the name of John Markins

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: unknown

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except second
degree burglary
