Application of Arthur Hayes

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination, or conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempt Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of December A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Five Years Indeterminate Sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Atty. E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Arthur Hayes I was convicted under the name of Arthur Hayes

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Harry Hett

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
