Application of Arthur Hayes

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the ninth day of December
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to five years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Arthur Hayes
I was convicted under the name of Arthur Hayes

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Harry Stett

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
