First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempt Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Ninth day of December
A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Five years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Arther Hayes

I was convicted under the name of Arther Hayes
