I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a release on Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the May 26<sup>th</sup> day of May  
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial Dist. Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Morris L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of  
from not less than one nor more than twenty  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison, commit-  
ment be on the 15<sup>th</sup> of October 1924

Fourth-- Honorable Edgar A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Fred Widmer

I was convicted under the name of Fred Widmer

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: - none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except - On the Forgery  
charge, was given a suspended sentence in  
May 26<sup>th</sup> 24 and was subsequently arrested on  
a similar charge, on or about the 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup>  
of Oct. automatically putting the indeterminate  
sentence into effect
