Application of George Porter

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of Feb. A. D. 1921, at Fillmore County of Millard and State of Utah, in Fifth District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Knox presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable William Higgins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George E. Porter I was convicted under the name of George E. Porter

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny
