First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of Dec. A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ephraim Hanson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Dodge prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles H. Edwards I was convicted under the name of Charles H. Edwards.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: York Van Nixon.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Pecuniary stolen property, Common Assault.
