Application of Roy Willyerd

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Prison of Dec. 21, 1923, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Adultery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of June, A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable G. A. Stevenson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate term in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable G. A. Stevenson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Roy Willyerd. I was convicted under the name of Roy Willyerd.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
