Application of Al Vincent

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 25 day of June A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City Utah County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Six months to Three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Glenwood S. L. Vincent I was convicted under the name of Al Vincent

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Petit Larceny.
