To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Board  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am <sup>paroled</sup> serving a term of imprisonment in Beaver, Utah  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of February  
A. D. 1925, at Beaver City County of Beaver  
and State of Utah, in Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. C. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term in the State Prison  
from one to twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison, having been paroled in the  
month of June, 1925, since which time I have resided at Beaver City,  
Utah, with my mother.

Fourth-- Honorable G. H. Lunt and W. F. Knox prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Marion Tassell

I was convicted under the name of Marion Tassell

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Harvey A. Dean

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except possession of liquor.
