I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~penitentiary~~ or parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Box Elder County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of unlawfully transporting intoxicating liquor

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of July A. D. 1925, at Brigham City County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in City Court of Brigham Utah Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Fred J. Holton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Six months in the Box Elder County jail and thereafter was imprisoned in the Box Elder County Jail

Fourth-- Honorable J. W. Horsely, County Attorney prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Clark I was convicted under the name of William Clark

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Hawkins who has been heretofore paroled or pardoned by the Board of Pardons.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except one a misdemeanor
