Dear Sir:

Answering your letter of July 22nd, which I have just received upon my return from an absence of a few days, I will say that in reporting your case to the State Board of Pardons I recommended the minimum period of imprisonment under the statute, that of one year, and I will say that if the State Board of Pardons shall find upon examining your application that you have, as you say, conducted yourself properly and commendably during your stay at the Prison and that your reformation has been accomplished, I have no objection to your term being cut short and your application granted next month, and I will so inform the State Board of Pardons.
